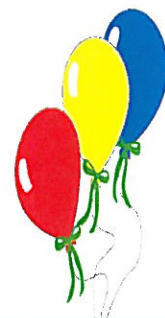
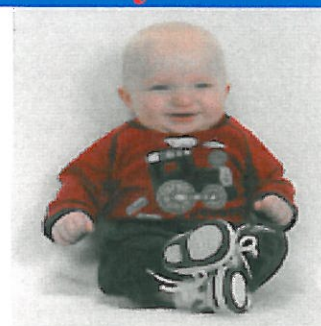


Bowl For Rachel, Joey, Matthew & Tyler

RACHEL is 6 y.o and enjoys gymnastics, playing with her brother Gregory and attending school. Rachel was diagnosed with Leukemia on Aug. 2006 and from that day on her world was turned upside down. Besides the chemotherapy once a week, Rachel endures frequent bone marrow testing & spinal taps. Rachel is in good spirits and remains positive and determined to beat the disease.

JOEY is a 11 y.o. boy who loves playing basketball, baseball and golf. Joey was diagnosed with Juvenile Dermatomyositis (JDM), an autoimmune disease that attacks the body's muscle tissue on Oct.16, 2007. Joey went from being an athletic, active boy to immobile and in a wheelchair within 12 weeks after diagnosis. His parents, Larry & Denise, believe that "Joey was chosen to battle this disease to help prepare him for the road God has created for him."

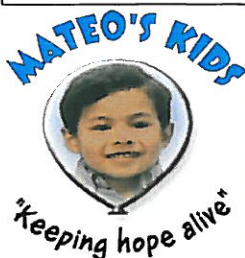
MATTHEW is a 18 y.o. boy who was born with cerebral palsy and is now confined to a wheelchair. He recently had spinal fusion therapy due to his severe scoliosis & lordosis. As a result of his medical condition, he continues to have vision and heart problems. With surmounting medical bills Matthew's parents, ? & Penny find it "very scary when you have a disabled child and can't give him all he needs to make the quality of life the best it can be."

TYLER is a 6 ½ month old and was diagnosed with a rare cancer of the liver, Hepatoblastoma. Besides the grueling chemotherapy treatments, Tyler had surgery to remove a tumor that covered 65% of his liver on June 11th, 2008. His parents, James & Dawn, say their baby has been through so much that could "even make a grown man cry."
